## Excursions & Activities:

**Uluru walking Tour** - explore the beautiful land that surrounds Uluru. Get up close and personal and touch the rock and accompany your guide through one of the most important habitation areas for the Aboriginal people.

**Kata Tjuta Valley of the Winds Walk** - Kata Tjuta simply translated means 'heads many' and has 36 steep-sided domes. This incredible formation of rock domes extends six kilometres into the ground and is the remains of erosion that began more than 500 million years ago. We will walk in the Valley of the Winds. This walk can be a little challenging, but well worth the effort. It takes you down into a timeless haven within the domes through trickling creek beds and ends with an amazing view!

**Award Winning Sounds of Silence Experience** - As the sun sets and darkness falls, listen to the sound of a didgeridoo and join your table for an unforgettable dining experience and an introduction to Aboriginal culture with a traditional performance under the outback sky. As the night sky twinkles to life, help yourself to a bush tucker inspired buffet then settle back and listen to our resident star talker decode the southern night sky. This experience will be a once in a lifetime moment that you will talk about forever.

**Field of Lights** - As darkness falls and Uluru is thrown into silhouette, Field of Light illuminates. As far as the eye can see, gentle rhythms of colour light up the desert. This art installation is Bruno Munro's largest work to date. Overwhelming in size, covering more than seven football fields, it invites immersion in its fantasy garden of 50,000 spindles of lights. Truly an amazing experience!

**Camel Ride** - Join your leader for a short ride on an outback camel. Uluru Camel Tours is Australia largest camel farm with more than 60 working camels. This unique experience will be a great selfie taking moment that you won't soon forget.

## How do I apply?

**Step 1:** Please select the program date that suits you best. Our programs are organised carefully around selected dates so that you won't miss any classes.
