Mitai Māori cultural experience & Hangi feast - The Mitai traditional stories unfold through the dynamic scenes of warriors paddling the war canoe down Wai-o-Whiro stream. The melodious sounds of instruments and entertainment are highlighted through the haka and performing arts. Enjoy the traditional Hangi dinner followed by an evening walk through the forest visiting the old village site and discovering the sacred natural spring Te Puna Tapu a Tuhoe.

Guided Tour of the Hobbiton Movie set - Join a guided tour and experience the real Middle-earth at the Hobbiton Movie set, where, in the heart of the Waikato region, you can step into the lush pastures of the shire as seen in The Lord of the Rings and The Hobbit film trilogies. Journey past the colourful Hobbit Hole doors that scatter the hillsides, including the iconic Bag End, home of Bilbo and Frodo Baggins, before arriving at Bagshot Row for a glimpse of the interior of the humble Hobbit's home.

Ultimate ziplining canopy tour - Unveiling New Zealand's natural identity around every corner, this Ultimate Ziplining experience just keeps on giving! Transporting you further into the lush canopy with longer zip lines, higher suspended swing bridges, and a one of a kind custom built spiral staircase. The expert team will keep you attached at every point while this ziplining experience elevates all your senses!

Scenic Gondola with luge through the ancient trees - The 900-metre long Doppelmayr cableway system will transport you and your friends on a gentle, scenic ride up to the Skyline Rotorua complex. Once you arrive at the top you have time to take in the amazing scenery with views to Lake Rotorua and the city before jumping into your own personal luge cart for a thrilling ride down the mountain! You will get three luge rides included and afterwards you might want to take a rest at the café and sip a coffee with your friends before taking the Gondola back down.

Guided Geothermal walk with healing mud pool indulgence -Come experience a land where myth and legend come to life, where the earth boils, mud heals, and steam disappears into the clouds above. Take part in a guided geothermal walk before indulging in a dip into the geothermal mud & sulphur waters that the local maori have been using for its healing powers for centuries.

How do I apply?

Step 1: Please select the program date that suits you best. Our programs are organised carefully around selected dates so that you won't miss any classes.

The PEPA team will let you know the date you need to land into Rotorua Airport to meet the group for each program before you book your flight.

Step 4: Once you have confirmed your round trip flight to Rotorua Airport or bus transportation from Auckland please let your PEPA representative know immediately. You will receive your final trip itinerary 1 month prior to departing so you will have plenty of time to plan ahead.
